DPRK Repatriation/Recovery



- 55 boxes have been undergoing full forensic analyses
 - ❖ Largest single turnover; first since 2007
 - Commingling and degradation are challenging
 - Seven (7) accounted for; 25 more over next three (3) weeks
- Still open to remains recovery (last one in 2005)
 - Separate track from denuclearization
 - Discussed during Hanoi Summit, but unable to arrange 2019 field operations with North Korean Army
 - After DMZ meeting, sent letter to them to arrange work in 2020
 - DoD Proposal ready to present







Korean War Accounting



- Korean War Disinterment Project progressing well
 - ❖ Phase 1 (of 7) completed in March
 - Phase 2 underway
 - ❖ Totals since 1999: 306 disinterred, 132 identified
- Korean War Identification Project consolidates all lab efforts associated with Korean War remains









Other Items of Note



- DPAA MAKRI collaboration continues to improve
- South Korea independently pursuing recovery in DMZ with much success
- US-Russia Joint Commission generating some progress
- Working with China's People's Liberation Army (PLA) Archives Department




