Cold War



- **Accounted for 21 of 147 (126 still unaccounted for)**
- **China**
 - **Continuing to pursue People's Liberation Army Archives' info**
 - **Have requested info on two specific aircraft loss cases**
- **Russia**
 - **Working to expand USRJC support**
 - **Continuing archival research efforts (DPAA Det Moscow)**
 - **Conducted a joint investigation near Vladivostok last year**
 - **Excavation mission planned for September 2019**





Korean War Accounting



- **Accounted for 505 of 8,156 MIAs (7,648 still MIA)**
- **Conducting Phase 2 (of 7) to disinter all 652 Korean War Unknowns from the Punchbowl**
- **Cooperation with ROK counterparts continuing to grow**
 - MAKRI collaborating with DPAA on their Arrowhead Hill (DMZ) ops
 - Signing a new agreement for additional scientific cooperation with ROK Ministry of Interior and Safety's National Forensic Service Laboratory
- **DPAA Operations**
 - Successful Investigation mission in ROK last quarter
 - Planning another investigation and a recovery mission for next spring





Korean War Accounting - DPRK



- **Full year planning: Two (2) Basecamps, three (3) Joint Recovery Operations**
- **Logistics requirements necessitate an arrangement by end of November for full year operations**
 - **Final “window of opportunity” for any FY20 op closes by end of Apr 20**
